Brief Note: #Ürümchi Fire


- Zero-COVID quarantine policies started in 2022, August
- In Ürümchi, Gulca, Kaşger, Turfan, Hoten and other cities, people were completely confined to their homes and in the first days:
 - Doors welded, outgoing forbidden
 - Production was stopped, crops could not be collected from the fields, and farmers engaged in agriculture went bankrupt
 - The people of East Turkestan suffered a great economic earthquake
- Quarantine continued for a month. After 40 days:
 - \circ Food transportation, treatment facilities and other needs were not met
 - Dozens of people lost their lives in East Turkestan due to starvation and lack of treatment.
 - The people of East Turkestan revolted on social media.
 - In September, this event came to the world agenda as the Hunger Genocide.
- As the quarantine continues. After 100 days:
 - Despite all the ongoing backlash, there has been no official response from the Chinese side
 - In the late hours of 24 November, a fire broke out in a site where Uyghurs lived in Ürümchi. The fire that started on the 14th floor of the building continued to the 21st floor.
 - It is impossible for the families inside to escape, as the doors of the building, the security exit and even the doors to the roof are closed.
 - o Access to the site was not provided because the entrance roads of the fire brigade vehicles were blocked. In addition, it was also reflected in the media that firefighters waited without intervening.
 - The other reason for the death of the families in the fire was that the water supply of the building was cut off at the time of the fire.
 - Although China says that only 10 people lost their lives in the fire, it is seen in the social media posts that the number of people who lost their lives by burning or heat poisoning is at least over 40.
 - China said that the people were unable to save themselves sufficiently, in order to avoid the crime that it committed at the time of the fire.

- After the fire, several cities, including Ürümchi, rioted against China's COVID practices:
 - $\,\circ\,$ It is documented that the uprising in Ürümchi continued on 24 and 25 November.
 - Following the Ürümchi, on November 26 in Wuhan, Nanjiang, and Shanghai, on November 27 in Yenisar city of East Turkestan, the Chinese capital Beijing, Zhengzhou, Chengdu and Hangzhou cities, Chinese people took to the streets. The slogans used in the riots were to end the quarantine, resign Xi Jinping and allow people to go out. The rioters state that they rebelled in the street because they were not sure about their lives.
